Admissions

- Select career and educational goal
- Search colleges and request details
- Readiness/prerequisites Adult Ed
- Visit colleges and narrow search
- Complete admissions application
- Request transcripts
 - High School (guidance office)
 - GED (State Education Dept.)
 - Previous College(s) (Registrar's Office)
- Interview and placement testing
- Admissions Acceptance
- Deposit/Return Acceptance Card
- Immunization Requirements
- Attend orientation
- Register for classes & order books
- Manage tuition bill

Financial Aid

- Attend a financial aid night
- Request real-time pin from Dept. of Ed PIN online. Be sure to have your parents request one too.
- Create a financial aid folder and keep copies of all documentation
- Complete financial aid form(s)
 - FAFSA (all colleges require)
 - Financial Aid Profile?
 - College institutional form?
- 2-3 weeks after filing FAFSA, watch for SAR (Student Aid Report), review and correct if necessary
- Attend a College Goal Sunday event
- Submit any requested documentation to school, such as verification forms or tax returns.
- Once received, review your financial aid award letter
- Return award letter and other necessary documentation such as loan applications
- Complete promissory note for loans and student loan entrance interview (if applicable)
