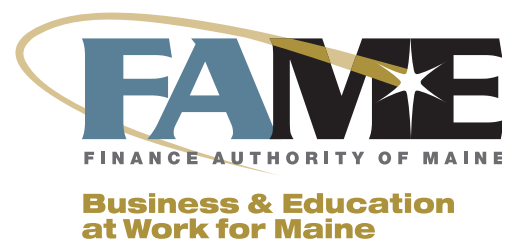

Several out-of-state postsecondary institutions are authorized by the Maine State Board of Education to offer specific programs in Maine that may not be available from Maine institutions.

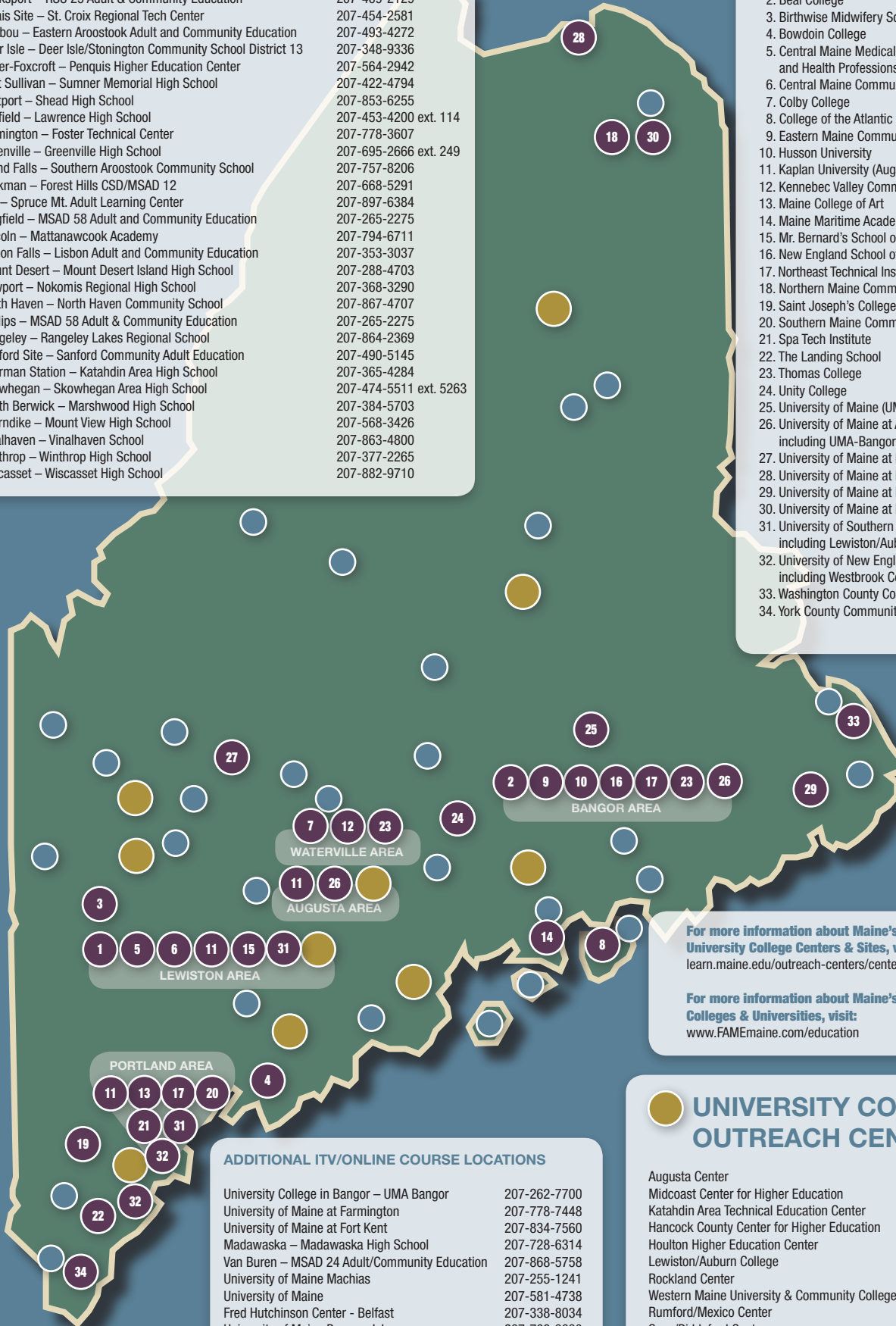

FINANCIAL AID

Four Basic Steps to Applying

Step 1 Prepare

- Research college costs using the Net Price Calculator (NPC) at the colleges you are applying to. NPC can be found on each college's website.
- Research financial aid deadlines and requirements at the colleges you are interested in attending.
- Some colleges require additional forms such as the CSS Profile, institutional forms, tax transcripts and W-2's.
- Research and apply for scholarships.

Step 2 Apply

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.gov.
- The FAFSA is free. You don't need to pay anyone to complete or submit your FAFSA.
- FILE ON TIME! Submit the FAFSA as soon after January 1 as possible.
- Don't wait until your taxes are completed; use estimated tax information and make changes later.
- It is important to provide your name, date of birth and social security number accurately on the FAFSA.
- The colleges you list on your FAFSA will receive your information electronically.
- Save your confirmation page.

Step 3 Follow-Up

- After filing your FAFSA you will receive your Student Aid Report (SAR) summarizing the information you provided on the FAFSA.
- Review your SAR for accuracy. If you used estimated tax information, be sure to make corrections at www.fafsa.gov once you have filed your tax return.
- Your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) is calculated based on the information you provide on the FAFSA and will be listed on your SAR.
- Your college may request additional information such as an IRS tax transcript or a verification form. It is crucial that you provide any additional documentation as quickly as possible.
- Failure to provide required information may result in a reduced financial aid package.

Step 4 Receive and Respond

- You will receive a financial aid award letter/notification from the colleges where you have been accepted.
- Many colleges begin sending (or e-mailing) financial aid awards in mid-March.
- Carefully review your award, including the types of aid that you are offered.
- Respond to the colleges and provide any additional forms, such as loan applications and student loan entrance counseling.
- Contact the financial aid office if you have questions.
